*Pay attention to your assigned Zoom times – be on time!

*Lunch will be together in squads. You will need to have a lunch “packed” so everyone can eat together with no interruption. This is what we would be doing in person! *Plan ahead and have it ready to go!*

-Camp lunches are very important. Pack something healthy, WATER ONLY, no sugary snacks!

*By this day all warm-ups should be learned.

*Be sure to have your water jugs ready with a good place designated for your practice. Rehearsal attire and online rehearsal etiquette is required for all sessions.

Squad leaders will be contacting students about an additional fun activity next week!

Charms & FamilyID Registrations, Fees

Practice Expectations

It is the staff's expectation that your child practices regularly at home. We suggest developing a practice schedule and sticking to it. **Warm ups** are particularly important and the students must start with those every time they sit down to practice, *no matter what.*

Students should be doing the Marching Health Workouts 3 times a week. I suggest the following:

Monday – Workout #1, Dynamic Warm Up

Wednesday – Dynamic Warm Up, Workout #2

Friday – Dynamic Warm Up, Workout #3

These should last only 10-15 minutes! Then go right into a music practice session for approx. 30 minutes.
