## Spectator Bus

### ***Reservations & Money due 10/26***

We will be offering a spectator bus to Championships on Sunday, October 31st! This is open to any friends and family who would like to go to the show! The coach bus will take you up and drop you off right at the door (no worrying about parking in downtown Syracuse!) then pick you up after our class is done. The bus will leave at 2:30PM, arrive around 7:00PM. Our class begins at 7:45PM and ends around 10:00PM. The bus will leave after the retreat, around 10:30PM, and return at approximately 2:30AM.

For those who have never traveled to Championships before, parking near the Carrier Dome is very tough and expensive. Taking the spectator bus is a great option for those unfamiliar with downtown Syracuse or those who don't want to deal with planning the day.

**The cost will be \$50 a person.** This does NOT include admission.

Call/text Traci Stevenson if you're interested in reserving seats 499-2661. The bus holds about 50 people and this is first come, first served. **ALL RESERVATIONS MUST BE MADE & PAID BY NEXT TUESDAY, OCTOBER 26TH!**

### 1) Ticket Prices:

- \$19.00 adult; \$13.00 student / senior citizens
- No presale tickets available for championships

### 2) Parking costs \$10.00

### 3) Handicap Parking:

- Check in at the Guard Booth at the corner of Irving Ave and East Raynor Ave. (Bottom of the hill at the Southwest corner of the Dome).
- You will be directed to the best parking area from there.
- Enter the Dome through Gate "A".
- This is a level approach to the Dome across from Forestry Drive.

### 4) No outside food or drinks allowed.

### 5) No noisemakers allowed.

### 6) No weapons of any kind allowed, including pocketknives. They will be taken.

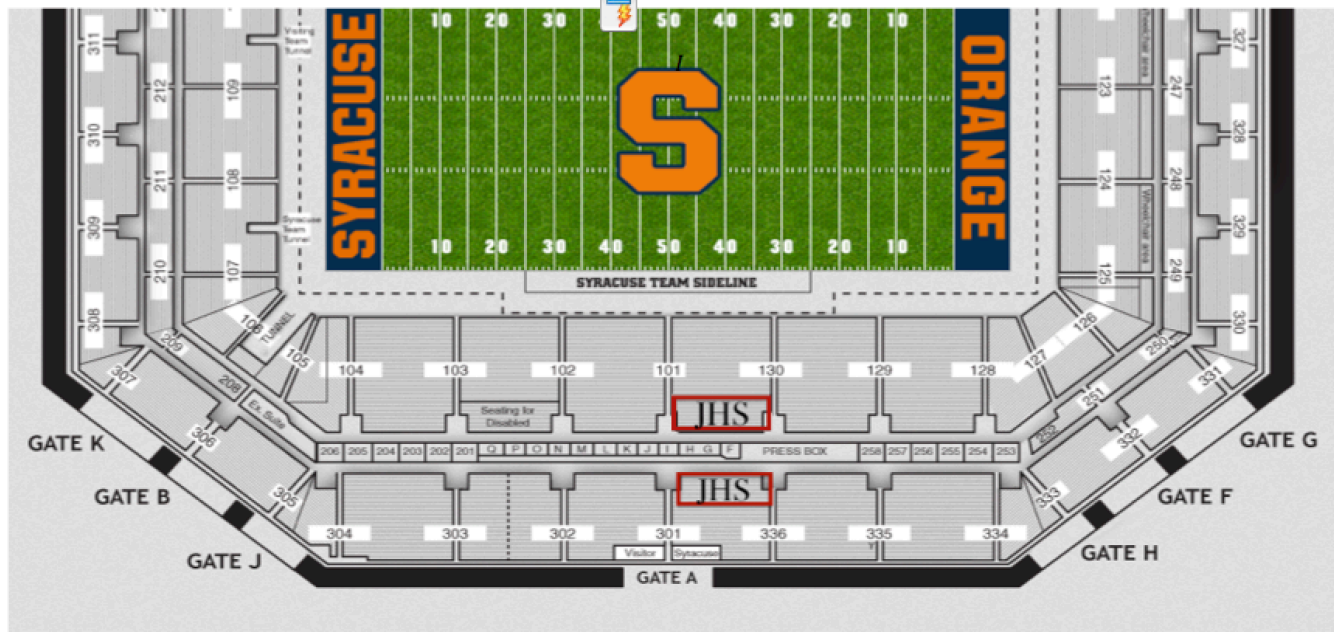
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# DOMESTIC SPECTATOR SEATING
