

<u>1 - Medication Information - VERY IMPORTANT</u></u>

a. FAMILYID

Please take a moment to review your FamilyID information. All health and contact information MUST be accurate and up-to-date before we leave Sunday.

b. PRESCRIPTION MEDICATION - MEDICATION ADMINISTRATION FORM

Students requiring prescription medication while on our trip MUST complete the **Medication Administration Form** (attached). **The child's doctor has a portion to complete**. NO MEDICATIONS WILL BE ALLOWED ON THIS TRIP WITHOUT THIS FORM.

a. Medication sent MUST be in the original bottle with only enough medication for the trip. DON'T SEND MEDICATION IN A ZIPLOC BAG. ORIGINAL PRESCRIPTION BOTTLE ONLY.

c. OVER-THE-COUNTER MEDICATION

Over-the-counter medicine (Tylenol, Advil, Dramamine, etc...) will **NOT** be allowed to be carried by students on the trip, unless it's listed on the Medication Administration Form. We will be carrying the following over-the-counter medications with us:

Tylenol, Advil, Aleve, Ibuprofen, Tums, Midol, Dramamine, Benadryl, Sudafed, cough syrup

Parents/guardians MUST complete this form to give permission for us to give this medication to the student. <u>https://forms.gle/ehByqAyAWeuC9k2g6</u> A hard copy of the form is attached if you cannot fill it out online.

2 - Important Spectator Info & Policies

- 1) Ticket Prices:
 - -Adult Price \$23 presale; \$25 at the door
 - -Senior Citizen/Student 18 or younger \$16 presale; \$18 at the door
 - -Student's (Public School Age) 18 and under \$16.00 presale, \$18.00 at the door
 - -All seating is general admission
 - -ONLINE presale tickets are now available!

You should save the mobile tickets to your phone's digital wallet, making it easier to enter the event. 2) Parking costs \$15.00. 3) Handicap Parking: Handicap parking is located near the Archibold gym. See an SU parking attendant for assistance.

4) No outside food or drinks allowed.

5) No noisemakers allowed.

6) No weapons of any kind allowed, including pocketknives. They will be taken.

7) JMA DOME ENTRANCE POLICY:

Spectators will be able to carry one of the following style and size bag at stadium gates:

- Bags that are clear plastic, vinyl or PVC and do not exceed 12" x 6" x 12" OR
- One-gallon clear plastic freezer bag (Ziploc bag or similar).

In addition, small clutch bags for personal items, approximately the size of a hand (4.5" x 6.5"), with or without a handle or strap, diaper bags (with child) and medically necessary items may be carried into the stadium along with one of the clear bag options, after proper inspection. Seat cushions and seat back chairs are permitted; however, they cannot have pockets, zippers or be in their own carrying bag.

Prohibited items include, but are not limited to: backpacks, binocular cases, briefcases, camera cases, cinch bags, computer bags, fanny packs, printed pattern plastic bags, tinted plastic bags, oversize totes, mesh bags, large purses, or any bag larger than the permissible size. Prohibited items must be returned to the owner's vehicle or discarded.

8) Jamestown Spectator Seating: We try to get all Jamestown spectators to sit together! It's much easier for the kids to see "The Sea of Red" that way. The suggested seating map is attached.

3 - Driving Directions to the JMA Wireless Dome

From I-90 take exit 39 toward I-690E Keep right at the fork, follow signs for I-690E/ Fairgrounds/Syracuse Continue onto I-690E Take the Interstate 81S exit toward Binghamton Merge onto I-81S Take exit 18 toward Harrison St/Adams St Keep left at the fork, follow signs for Adams St Turn right onto Almond St. Turn right toward Almost St/Van Buren St Slight left onto Almost St./Van Buren St Turn right onto Renwick Ave Turn right onto Fineview Pl Turn left onto E Raynor Ave Turn left onto Irving Ave

These directions came from Google Maps. You may be rerouted once you get closer depending on the parking situation.

<u>4 - Student Trip Info</u>

The students will receive a VERY detailed Syracuse Handbook this week. **YOU MUST GO THROUGH THIS PACKET WITH THEM!** They must bring it with them on the trip.

*Students meet no later than 6:30AM Sunday morning. Earlier is better!

*We will be staying at the Sheraton Syracuse University Hotel and Conference Center.

Any parents who are staying at the same hotel will not be permitted to meet up with their child at any point. When they are on this trip they are with us. This is for everyone's safety. Thank you for your understanding!

*The breakfast banquet is Monday morning at the hotel. **This is for students, staff and chaperones only.** *We will arrive back in Jamestown at 4:00PM on Monday, October 30.
