Attendance/On Time

Attendance is critical to the success of this program, each group, and each child.

Practice: Please make sure that you are at every practice. When you aren't there, it is impossible to move forward as a guard. However, if you do have to be absent or are going to be late, you MUST communicate with your director by phone call. **If absences start to add up, you may be asked to sit out of shows, to become an alternate, or to leave the program.** If you are in Caboose-call Emily Whitney (716-640-5668), if you are in Express-call Mrs. Marsh (716-338-7715). **On Time:** Remember, early is on time, on time is late! Guard members need to help get the floor tarp out before practice starts, so please try to arrive 10-15 minutes early. Also, please make every effort to pick your child up on time! Someone will obviously wait with them, but I would love it if the staff could also leave on time.

Shows: Everyone must be at every show. If you have a conflict you need to bring it to our attention ASAP so we can decide if you can move forward with this program or not.

Commitment: Please ensure that your child is fully committed to the whole season before moving forward. When people quit halfway through the season it puts a strain on other members to learn new spots and new choreography. If you start something, please finish it!

Family ID/Talking Points Notifications

Please take care of this ASAP!

All members have been automatically registered on TalkingPoints, all I need you to do is make sure that your notifications are on! I will send Guard Notes through TalkingPoints each week and send any urgent information or reminders! Family ID will take a little longer, but it is so important! This is where parent phone numbers are kept as well as emergency contacts and medical information. If this is not completed, we will have a hard time helping your child in the event of an emergency! There are also contracts on here that you must agree to.

Candy Bars

Please be sure to communicate with your child if you want a box of candy to sell or not. There are 52 bars in a box and they sell for \$2 each. Remember, \$50 from each box sold can be allocated towards anything including your team jacket, activity fee (dues), or a fundraiser you don't want to do. Please collect money in the envelope included in the box and hand that in with your name on it and what payment you would like that \$50 to go towards. When you want another box, you can message on TalkingPoints or text me/Emily.

Payments

Our first payment is due this week: \$50 for Caboose and \$100 for Express. We have already started to spend money, so I really need these in ASAP. If you are planning on doing extra fundraising to make this payment, please just message me/Emily your plan. Remember, cash and checks (made out to Jamestown Band and Chorus Association) should be in an envelope with the member's name on it!
